

## Baby socks / booties w/Roll top

Décor Accents fine-gauge  
Baby Booty loom (28 pins)

1 skein baby yarn (won't use whole skein)



Knit 11 rows.

Slip every seventh stitch to the peg before. This will leave small holes for the cord later.

Knit 2 rows.

Shape heel by working back and forth as a flat piece, knitting pegs\*

1 to 14

14 to 1

2 to 13

13 to 2

3 to 12

12 to 3

4 to 11

11 to 4

5 to 10

10 to 5

6 to 9

9 to 6

7 and 8

9 to 6

6 to 9

10 to 5

5 to 10

11 to 4

4 to 11

12 to 3

3 to 12

13 to 2

2 to 13

14 to 1

Working in the round again, knit 15 rows for foot.

Remove work from loom using gathering method.

Pull stitches together tightly and tie off on the back side of work.

\* To keep from having holes in the work, at the end of each row, remove the stitch from the peg next to the one you're working, put the loose end of yarn behind the peg and replace the stitch on the peg. Work next row as usual.

Make a twisted cord approximately 18 inches long. Thread through holes at beginning of heel shaping and tie a bow in front. Or, use a piece of ribbon.

Variation: Use a contrasting color for heel.
